

TRAILBLAZER VILLAGE

Greetings from Utah Tech University! Planning is underway for the Utah Tech Homecoming celebrations, September 23–28, 2024. We hope you will join us in our celebration.

1. Trailblazer Village will open at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 28, 2024. All Trailblazer Village activities must conclude at the start of the 3rd quarter of the UT Football game. Alumni, students, faculty, staff, guests and friends are encouraged to enter Greater Zion Stadium to cheer on the Utah Tech Football team. Trailblazer Village activities are not permitted to resume at any time during the second half of the football game. All tents and the area known as “Trailblazer Village” must be vacated two hours after the game has concluded.
2. All organizations, companies, community participants, alumni, students, faculty or staff must have a reservation on file with the Trailblazer Village Committee prior to September 16th to occupy a space in Trailblazer Village.
3. Organizations, companies, and individuals renting occupying space in the area known as Trailblazer Village will be responsible for abiding by the Trailblazer Village Policies. Please read and understand all policies related to Trailblazer Village, and Homecoming. By completing, signing and submitting the required forms, individuals, organizations, and companies/corporations agree to abide by all policies related to Homecoming, Trailblazer Village and other applicable local, state and federal laws. Failure to abide by Trailblazer Village policies will result in Trailblazer Village participation being terminated and denied in the future.
4. All registrations must be received by 5:00 p.m. on September 16, 2024. Reservations received after this date will be charged a \$25 late fee.
5. All tents must be secured using water barrels to ensure participant safety.

HOW TO RESERVE YOUR ORGANIZATION'S TENT IN TWO EASY STEPS:

1. Read and understand the 2024 Homecoming Trailblazer Village Policies and Overview
2. Fill out the Registration form
 - No electricity will be available and amplified music is not allowed.
 - The placement of all tents will be coordinated by the Trailblazer Village Committee
 - A detailed map of UT Trailblazer Village will be available prior to the event.
 - Due to the continued growth of trees and shrubs in the area known as Trailblazer Village, tent locations are not guaranteed as placement varies by tent size.
 - All organizations occupying space in the area known as Trailblazer Village must have a registration form on file with the Trailblazer Village Committee. Failure to do so will result in the organization being asked to vacate the premises.

HOW TO CLEAN UP YOUR ORGANIZATION'S TENT IN THREE EASY STEPS:

1. Pack up everything you brought with you... follow the pack it in, pack it out motto!
2. Dispose of all trash and recycling in the garbage bins and/or dumpsters.
3. Do a walk-through to make sure you have all of your things.

TRAILBLAZER VILLAGE POLICIES:

- All Trailblazer Village/tailgate participants and spectators must conduct themselves in ways to ensure the safety of themselves and others. Abusive and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
- Trailblazer Village will open at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 28, 2024. Alumni, students, faculty, staff and guests must vacate the area known as Trailblazer Village at the start of the 3rd Quarter of the Homecoming Football Game. Everyone is encouraged to enter Trailblazer Stadium to watch the remainder of the UT Football game. Trailblazer Village activities are not permitted to resume at any time during the second half of the football game. All tents should be vacated and surrounding areas known as Trailblazer Village should be vacated no later than 2 hours after the game.
- All Trailblazer Village/tailgate areas may close at the discretion of University Officials.
- Music and audio must be confined to individual tents. Amplified music is not permitted in the Trailblazer Village area. Music and noise that is disturbing other tents and/or participants is prohibited. All music must stop at 6:55 p.m. MST or prior to the playing of the National Anthem.
- Patrons that are disruptive will be asked to vacate the premises.
- Utah Tech University students are subject to conduct policy as outlined in the Utah Tech University Student Code of Rights and Responsibility.
- Open flame fires, including fire pits, are prohibited. Propane and charcoal grills are permitted.
- Alcoholic beverages are not permitted without the consent of the University
- Smoking is not allowed on university premises.
- Outside food or beverages are not allowed inside Greater Zion Stadium.
- Please show respect to the opposing team, game officials and each other.
- Persons throwing objects or participating in other acts in conflict with good sportsmanship and fair play are subject to ejection.
